### Innovative Lessons

Our Young Entrepreneurs course goes beyond textbooks. Every morning, students tackle real-world business challenges through case studies, videos, and creative workshops. Instead of grammar tests, we focus on speaking English with confidence and using it as a tool for ideas, debate, and persuasion.

#### **Practical Skills in Action**

This course is all about doing, not just listening. Students practise teamwork, negotiation, pitching, and presenting. These are the skills every entrepreneur needs. For many, it's the first time they put business English into practice in front of an audience, gaining confidence with every step.

### **Entrepreneurial Projects**

From designing logos to creating marketing campaigns, students turn ideas into reality. At Chichester Market, groups have sold their own T-shirts to the public, and this year we raised money for Oxfam with an in-house auction. These projects bring lessons to life and show students what they're capable of.

#### Confidence for the Future

By the end of the course, students aren't just better at English — they're ready to stand up and share their ideas with conviction. The experience of working in teams, pitching products, and engaging with a real audience gives them confidence that lasts long after the summer.
