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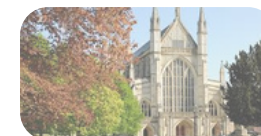
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A Note from Our Principal

SAFEGUARDING OF YOUNG LEARNERS

At the British Learning Academy, we look after our students welfare in every way to promote all aspects of their safety and well-being throughout their time with us. Some of the steps we take to ensure students' welfare:

All students are given an induction, highlighting the centre's rules and regulation to keep them safe.

All staff are at least Safeguarding Level 1 trained & Enhanced DBS-checked

Risk assessments are carried out and any necessary steps are taken to reduce the likelihood of problems both during students' stay at the school and when leaving school's premises.

Students are asked to wear a lanyard with the emergency numbers on, at all times.

All staff recognise their responsibility for the safeguarding of U18s and will immediately alert senior management of any concern. BLA staff are available 24 hours a day for any issue that may arise.

We require consent forms from parents who send under-age students to study English in the UK at our school.

ARRIVAL

We ask students to arrive on a Sunday or Monday, when airport transfers are organised by BLA. On arrival, you'll be welcomed by one of our staff members and escorted by train or taxi to your chosen campus. If you choose to arrive on another day, you will need to make your own way to the campus.

LESSONS

All English courses take place in the morning, from 09:00 until 12:45. On their first day, students will be assessed on their level of English and placed into class accordingly.

Portsmouth and Bristol offer single, twinned and multi-bed rooms, Portsmouth offers an ensuite block. Bed linens and towels are provided and changed throughout the duration of the student's visit.

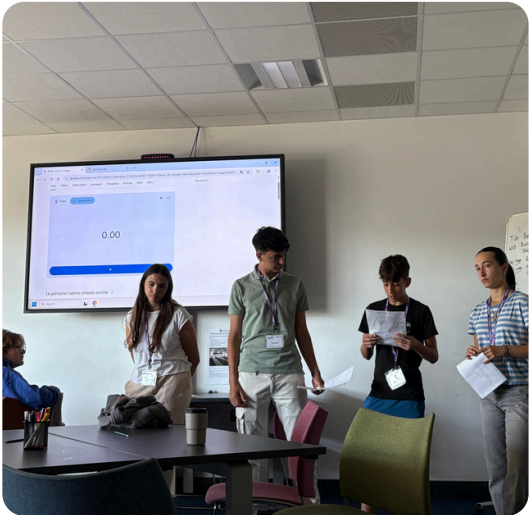

OUR COURSES

GENERAL ENGLISH COURSE

Our General English course is designed to support learners at every stage, with classes carefully tailored to five levels: Elementary (A1), Pre-Intermediate (A2), Intermediate (B1), Upper-Intermediate (B2), and Advanced (C1).

Following our distinctive house style, lessons place a strong emphasis on developing speaking fluency and building confidence in real-life communication. Alongside this, students work on key areas of language learning — including grammar, vocabulary, listening, reading, and writing — adapted to the needs of each level.

The course is interactive and dynamic, ensuring that students not only improve their English but also gain the practical skills and confidence to use it effectively in everyday situations, academic contexts, or international settings.



CAMBRIDGE AND TRINITY EXAMINATION PREP

Our exam preparation courses are tailored to young learners and taught by experienced teachers. Students practice with real exam-style tests to gain confidence and improve performance. Along the way, they expand their vocabulary, strengthen grammar, and develop communication skills. Students can choose to prepare for either the Cambridge Exams or the Trinity GESE, gaining internationally recognised qualifications that showcase their English skills.

ACTIVITIES

From 14:15 each day on campus, students will have a range of afternoon activities to choose from. Our Activity Leaders deliver sports sessions; football, basketball, volleyball, and many more.

There are alternative indoor sessions available; arts and crafts, talent show workshop and t-shirt logo design as an example. Each activity is an opportunity for our students to immerse themselves in English, and practice their speaking skills with our Activity Leaders and peers.

From 20:00, students participate in a range of evening activities. To name a few, our Activity Leaders are experienced in leading Murder Mystery, Zombie Night and Trashion Show.
