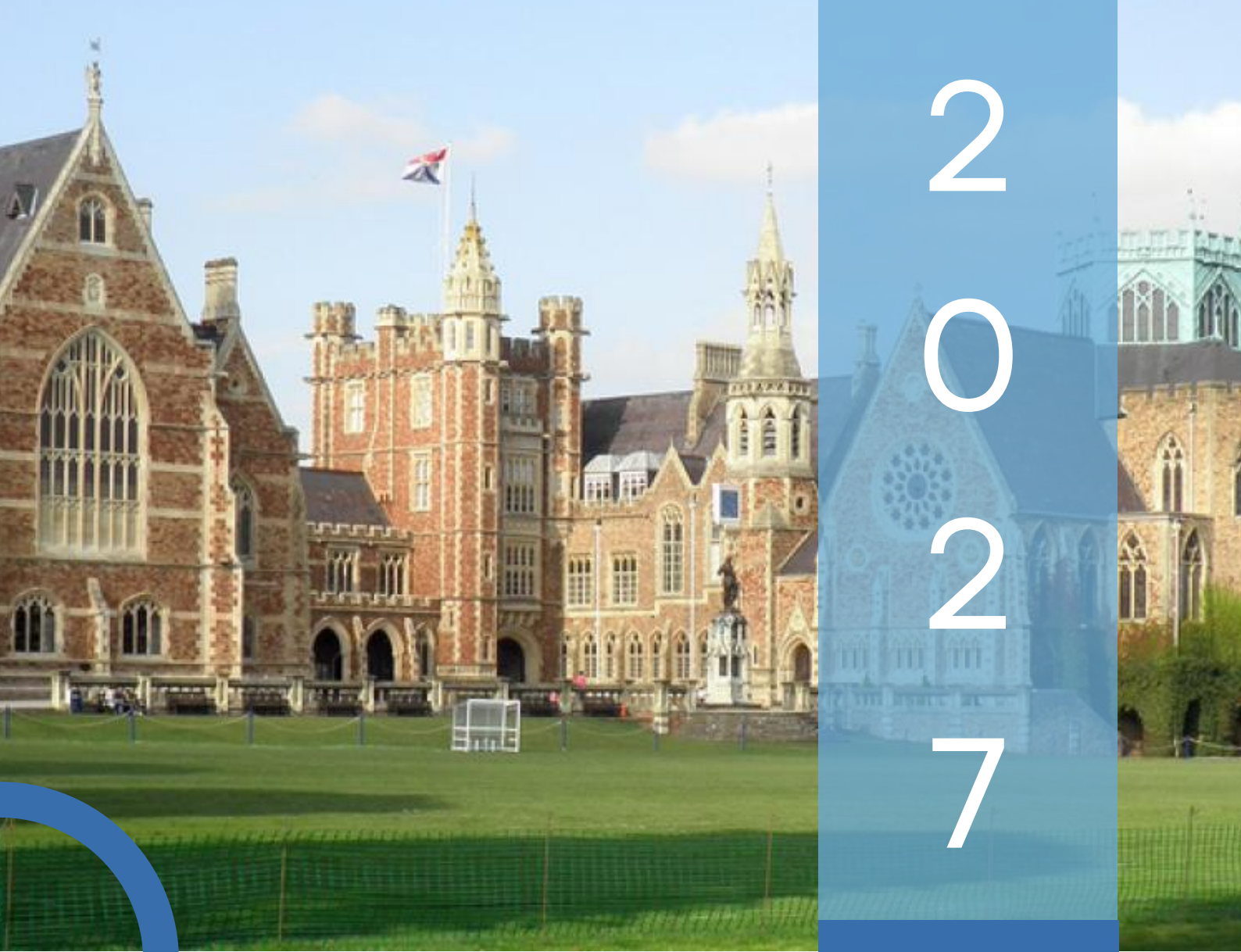

A true boarding experience: safe houses, friendly staff, and friends from around the world—right on campus.

Students are accommodated in spacious and comfortable boarding houses, offering a mix of single, twin, and a few multi-bed rooms. A laundry service is included in your stay at Clifton.

Group leaders benefit from en-suite rooms, while students share bathroom facilities, which are cleaned daily.

Each boarding house also features welcoming common rooms, providing the perfect space for students to gather, relax, and socialise in a safe and friendly environment.

Fast facts: 24/7 supervision, great meals, zero commute, maximum fun and focus.



FACILITIES

Students have access to Clifton College's on-site Sports Centre and playing fields, a short walk from our classrooms and boarding houses.

These spaces provide a safe, supervised setting for afternoon activities and evening programmes.

- Swimming Pool – 25 m indoor pool, lifeguarded and booked for our supervised sessions.
- Sports Hall – multi-use indoor space for basketball, football, volleyball and badminton.
- Studios – suitable for dance, fitness and small-group activities.
- Tennis Courts – on-site courts for drills and friendly matches.
- The Close (Playing Fields) – central green space for football, rugby, rounders and team games.

Note: Students under 18 are not permitted to use the gym/fitness suite. Sessions focus on supervised, age-appropriate activities in the spaces listed above.



CANTEEN

The British Learning Academy provides full catering to our students. The timing are as follows:

Breakfast: 8:00-8:45

Lunch: 13:00- 13:45

Dinner: 19:00-19:45

At Clifton College, students take their meals in the main on-campus dining hall, just a short walk from the boarding houses and classrooms. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are served every day, with a wide choice of hot and cold dishes to suit all tastes. Menus are balanced and varied, with vegetarian/vegan/halal options always available and special dietary needs (allergies, religious or medical reasons) catered for on request.

The relaxed, self-service setting makes it easy for students to eat together, socialise and recharge between lessons and activities. Our staff are on hand to ensure everyone is well looked after and that mealtimes run smoothly.



TEACHING ROOMS

Location Lessons take place in dedicated teaching rooms within Clifton College, set around The Close in the heart of campus.

Facilities Bright, well-equipped classrooms with AV/projectors, whiteboards and flexible seating for pair work, group tasks and interactive learning. Maximum 15 students per class.

Proximity A short walk from the boarding houses, dining hall and sports centre—everything is close and easy to navigate.

Supervision Students are supervised by our staff at all times during lessons, activities and excursions. Clifton campus is enclosed.
